Participating in an international exchange program as an undergraduate university student is a transformative experience. At St. Norbert, exchange students will discover a classic collegiate experience. They'll find a welcoming campus, challenging academics, attention to the individual student and more than 80 student clubs and organizations. St. Norbert offers students exceptional opportunities to make friends, immerse themselves in U.S. culture and become a vital part of the SNC community.

We offer:

- **J-1 visa assistance** – From the time of acceptance to enrollment, our professional staff assists students in navigating the U.S. SEVIS system.
- **Guaranteed on-campus housing** – Full integration into our residential campus begins with on-campus housing; our staff works with each individual to find the best option for them. A variety of dining options are available across campus.
- **Academic-break housing** – Students on a full-year exchange may stay in our on-campus housing at no extra charge during academic breaks.
- **Airport pickup** – A member of our staff will meet new exchange students at the Austin Straubel International Airport and bring them to their new home on campus.
- **Exchange student orientation** – During the first few days on campus and throughout the first semester, we offer orientation programs to help students fully integrate into the campus community and make friends.
- **Individual academic counseling** – The director of international student and scholar services serves as the academic advisor, helping exchange students select classes that will transfer back to their home university.
- **One- or two-semester terms** – Students have their choice of a 5-month (fall or spring) or 9-month term (fall and spring).
