Funds Administered By Faculty Development

Faculty Development Funds

Expressly designed to help faculty defray the cost of a broad range of professional growth activities and projects, all faculty members are eligible to apply for Faculty Development Funds prorated on the number of undergraduate courses taught per year. You may submit your application to the Office of Faculty Development any time during the fiscal year (June 1 - May 31), using the current year form.

Fund for Pedagogical Development

All full-time, tenure track faculty are eligible to apply for the awards available in the fiscal year (June 1 – May 31), and they will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. This fund is designed to help faculty attend a professional conference in order to stay current in the areas of pedagogy and instructional technology in their field. The faculty member will share what he/she has learned with colleagues upon returning. Summer Grant Awards

All full-time, tenure track faculty are eligible to apply for awards. This source of in-house financial support is designed to encourage scholarly, pedagogical, and creative growth during the summer months. Awards are competitive. Applications are due in the Office of Faculty Development by 4:30 p.m. on the due date, usually the end of January.
