Throughout the year we will host a series of presentations to recognize professional achievement in scholarship and to celebrate the rich diversity and talents of our colleagues.

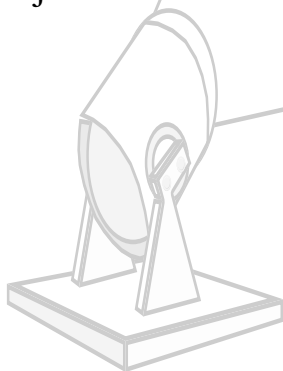
This Spotlight on Scholarship features

“The Joy of Boron: A Gourmet Guide to Luminescence”

Boron is a quirky little element whose main job appears to be confounding chemistry students by being the exception to all the rules. However, it is this “rule-breaker” quality that allows chemists to use boron, guided by their imagination and creativity, to generate new avenues from familiar chemical paths.
