2. in high-need subject areas;
3. four years of teaching must be completed within eight years after you complete or otherwise cease to be enrolled in the program for which you received a TEACH Grant; **and**,
4. at schools that serve students from low-income families.

**If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient.** The loan is a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.
